The SUNY Poly LPP program offers a wide range of student based services concentrated in academic support, career exploration and social emotional skill building.

### Individual Academic Support Meetings:

Provided monthly to support students personally identified academic, career and social goals

### Personalized Learning Plans:

Designed to meet each students individualized academic, career, and personal goals

### Social Emotional Assessments:

Targeted to assess each students individual social emotional development level

### Career Exploration & Employment Preparation:

Connection to tools and resources to help students meet their academic and career goals including connection to higher education through college tours and resume building

### Afterschool Programming:

Offered regularly in district and expanding to include civic engagement, leadership programming and specialized field programming in addition to academic support

Through our Institutions of Higher Education, LPP offers strong school and community partnerships that deliver research-based programming to students enrolled in public and non-public schools to promote positive outcomes.
