



Criteria - Students must fall under one or more of the following qualifications for being considered eligible for enrollment.

History of academic failure. Defined by failing grades in two or more subjects over the last two semesters.

History of Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACEs) including emotional, physical, or sexual abuse, parental incarceration, parental substance abuse, parental mental or physical health issues, parental neglect, divorce or death.

Homelessness and or severe family financial stress.

Family and or peer history of poor academic performance and failure to meet high school.

History of discipline or problems and or behavior problems defined as two or more referrals during an academic semester.

Inconsistent school attendance or truancy is defined as having more than 10 absences in 1 semester or more than 20 absences in an academic year.

Foster care placement

Bullying history as either a perpetrator or victim

Teen pregnancy and/or parenting

Poor English language proficiency
