About the Program:

Student Ambassadors are current students who are prepared to answer any questions a student, parent or guidance counselor might have about life on campus, the academic experience, Utica or anything else at SUNY Polytechnic Institute.

- Ambassadors serve as representatives of SUNY Poly and are often the first person a campus visitor will meet. They
 should maintain a standard of personal conduct consistent with the values, expectations and responsibilities of SUNY
 Polytechnic Institute.
- Ambassadors are require to work at least 6 hours per week in the admissions office in addition to mandatory admissions events throughout the year including:
 - o Fall Open House- October 21st
 - o Spring Open House- April 7th
 - o Accepted Student Day -March 23rd
 - o Information Days
 - October 9th
 - November 10th
 - February 19th
 - o Phone-a-thon Nights-TBD
- Student Ambassadors must achieve and maintain "good academic standing," which is defined as having completed a semester with a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 or higher. Final appointment for the 2017-2018 academic year is contingent upon spring 2017 semester grades.
- Students must have completed 2 semesters of coursework at SUNY Poly to be applicable.
- Compensation will be half of the 19 meals per week meal plan for residential students. There is no ability to change the meal plan options as it is set by the Sodexo contract.

Applicants must complete items 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 as follows on an additional sheet of paper:
