

- A.) Social Science Elective: AN101, BM101, GE101, PS101, PY101, SO101. **Poly recommends students take SO 101 & PY 101.**
- B.) Math Elective: MA108, MA110, MA115, MA118, MA119, MA121, MA122, MA125, MA131, MA139, MA140, MA150, MA151, MA152, MA172. **Poly recommends students take MA 110 as one of Two required math courses.**
- C.) Free Elective: complete at least 15 credits from any 100 level course except PE *and* complete two 200 level courses
SUNY Poly Recommends students take the following courses to complete some of the Elective requirements:
-CJ 101 (taken before possible 200 level CJ course)
-SO 205 or SO 206
-1 or 2 200 level Sociology courses besides SO 205 or SO 206
-1 or 2 200 level Psychology course or 200 level Criminal Justice course
